With reference to your complaint against Dr. Uma Sharma and Dr. Balraj, this is to inform you that the Disciplinary Committee of the Delhi Medical Council has examined your complaint and after due deliberation has concluded that there was no violation of medical ethics on the part of Dr. Uma Sharma nor Dr. Balraj in this case.

The Committee has, however, observed that Health Education be imparted to the public and people can avail of the services of nearest medical facilities and the Ambulance services, rather than depending on individual doctors in dire emergency. The Delhi Medical Council has considered the findings of the Disciplinary Committee and concurs with their decision.
